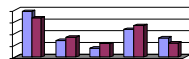

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Definitions

Age: is calculated by subtracting the year of birth from the year of the semester report; it does not take into account the month of birth.

Age Categories: recodes the variable “Age” by ordering students into one of the following age categories:

- <18
- 18-21
- 22-25
- 26-30
- 31-39
- 40+

Course Level: involves the grouping of semester credit hours (SCH) into one of the following course categories based on the Coordinating Board’s course designation. Note, professional level courses are non-funded and excluded from SCH and Weighted SCH calculations. Thus, there is not a course level designation for this category.

- Lower
- Upper
- Masters
- PhD

College: specifies either: 1) the college to which a student’s major is assigned or 2) the college to which a course is assigned.

Department: designates the four-letter abbreviation specifying either: 1) the department to which a student’s major is assigned or 2) the department to which a course is assigned.

Enrollment Status: this variable categorizes students into one of the following admissions categories:

1st Time in College: an undergraduate, degree seeking, student who applied and enrolled in college for the first time regardless of whether the student has acquired college level credit through testing, advanced placement or summer enrollment. This field is used only the first semester of a student's enrollment at TAMU.

1st Time Graduate: a graduate student who has never attended another post-secondary institution at the same level for which they have applied. This field is used only the first semester of a student's enrollment at TAMU.

1st Time Professional: a professional student who has never attended a professional program at another post-secondary institution. This field is used only the first semester of a student's enrollment at TAMU.

1st Time Transfer: a student entering TAMU for the first time but who is known to have previously attended another post-secondary institution at the same level (e.g. undergraduate to undergraduate, or masters to masters, not undergraduate to masters). This does not include an institution's own graduates who re-enter for further education. This field is used only the first semester of a student's enrollment at TAMU.

Re Admitted: a student who previously attended TAMU and is enrolled after applying for readmission.

Continuing: an undergraduate, master's, doctoral or professional student who has completed at least one full semester at TAMU with no break in regular semester enrollment.

Ethnic Origin: is the code indicating the ethnic origin of the student. Students are classified as "International" if they are not citizens of the United States but are in the United States on a temporary basis and do not have the right to remain indefinitely. Non-citizen students, who are lawfully admitted for permanent residence, or Resident Aliens, are reported in the appropriate racial/ethnic category along with United States Citizens. The unknown classification is reserved for students that have not selected a racial/ethnic designation.

Ft/Pt: 12 and 9: calculates full- part-time status using Coordinating Board criteria. A full-time undergraduate student is defined as one who is registered for at least 12 semester credit hours during a fall or spring semester, at least 4 hours in a 5-week summer session and at least 8 hours in a 10-week summer semester. A full-time graduate student is defined as a student possessing a baccalaureate degree who is registered for at least 9 semester credit hours during a fall or spring semester, at least 3 hours in a 5-week summer session and at least 6 hours in a 10-week summer semester.

Gender: identifies a student as either “male” or “female”

Major: designates the four-letter abbreviation specifying the student’s declared major.

Residency Status: categorizes students into one of the following three categories based on the state or foreign country in which the student resides (where the student lives at the time of application).

- Texas Resident
- Non-TX, US Resident
- Non-TX, Non-US Resident

SCH Categories: groups students into one of the following categories based on the sum total of all the semester credit hours for which a student is enrolled without regards to funding.

- < 6 SCH
- 6-8 SCH
- 9-11 SCH
- 12-14 SCH
- 15-17 SCH
- >18 SCH

Student Level and Classification: involves the grouping of students into the following student level designation.

<u>Student Level</u>	<u>TAMU Classification</u>
Undergraduate	U0, U1, U2, U3, U4, U5
Masters	G6, G7, G9
Doctoral	G8
Professional	V1, V2, V3, V4

Tuition Status: indicates a student's status for tuition purposes. (For specifics on the residence tuition policy contact the Office of Admissions.)

Resident Tuition: students who pay “Resident Tuition” rates.

Non-Resident Tuition: students who pay “Non-Resident Tuition” rates.

Tuition Exemption/Waiver: students who pay “Resident Tuition” rates because they are granted a tuition exemption or waiver.

Total SCH: a mathematical computation that takes into account the semester credit value associated with a given course and the number of students enrolled in the respective course.

WSCH: a mathematical computation that takes into account student classification, course SCH total and level designation, and the respective program weight as assigned by the Coordinating Board. This report includes non-funded PhD Hours.

Notes & References

1. **% Change:** will be based on a comparison of the current semester's data to the prior like semester's data. Due to the way data was collected in the past, % change is not available this semester.
2. **The George Bush School of Government and Public Service:** as of July 27, 1999, the George Bush School of Government and Public Service became an independent academic unit no longer affiliated with the College of Liberal Arts resulting in a shift of SCH and Weighted SCH from the department of POLS in the College of Liberal Arts to the department of BUSH in the George Bush School of Government and Public Service.
3. **The Department of Performance Studies (PRFM):** effective July 7, 1999, the Department of Performance Studies was created; courses with the prefix MUSC and THAR were moved to this newly created department resulting in a shift of SCH and Weighted SCH from PHUM and SCTA to PRFM.
4. **The Department of Speech Communications (SCOM):** effective July 7, 1999, the Department of Speech Communications was created; courses with the prefix SCOM were moved to this newly created department resulting in a shift of SCH and Weighted SCH from SCTA to SCOM.
5. **WSCH:** include non-funded PhD Hours.
6. **WSCH with Teaching Supplement:** tenure codes have not been confirmed for 72 course offerings (or .6% of the course offerings) in Spring 2000. A conservative assumption was made that the courses would not be augmented by the teaching supplement.
7. **SCH and WSCH calculations:** do not include hours taken by professional students.

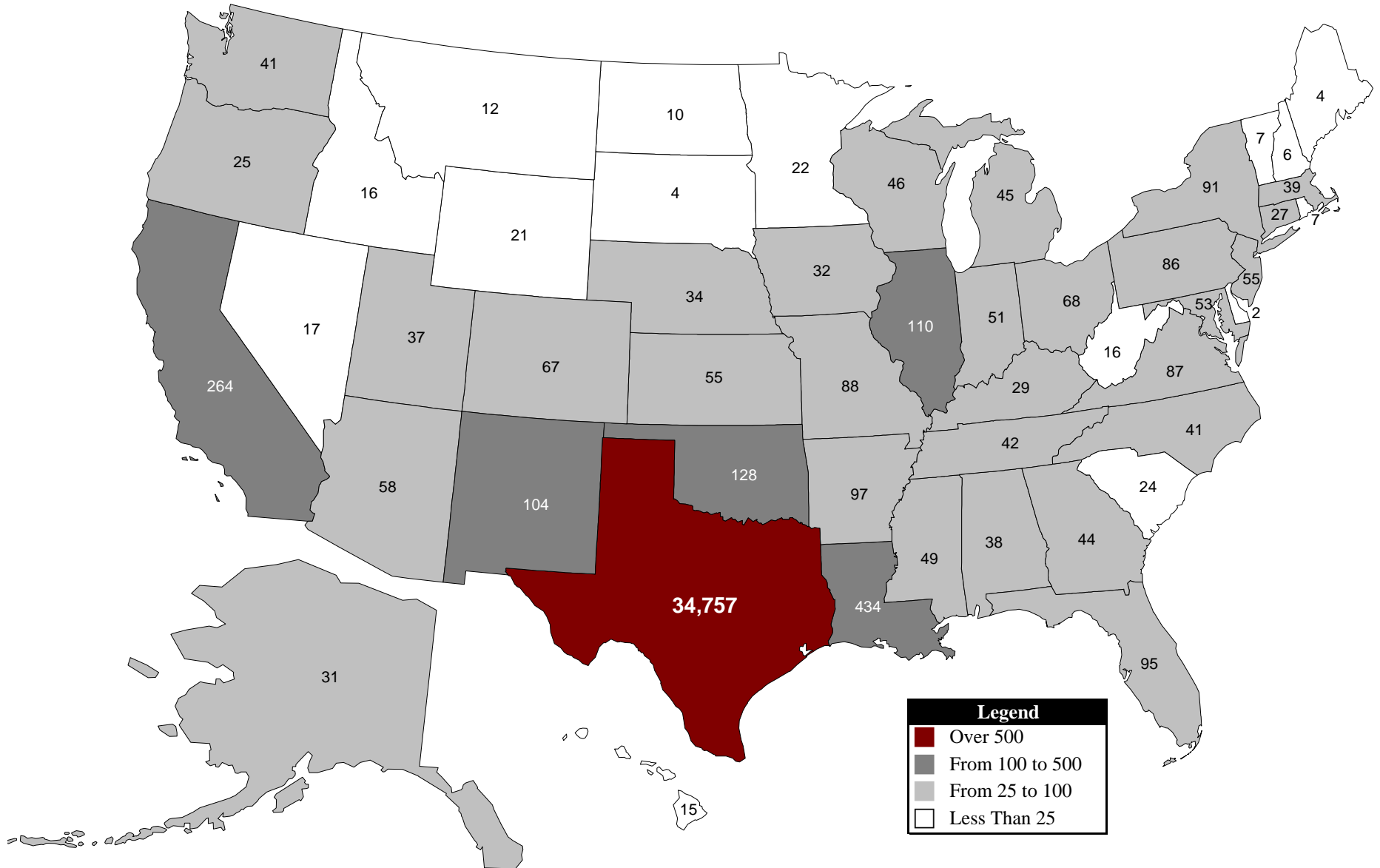
