Energy Conservation

TAMU has improved energy efficiency from FY02 - FY07 by 28.7% based on improvement in the Campus Energy Use Index, measured in mBtu* consumption per gross square foot (GSF). If energy consumption per GSF had not improved since FY02, TAMU would have paid \$46.6 million more.

*Btus are measurement of energy consumption. mBtu stands for one million Btus.

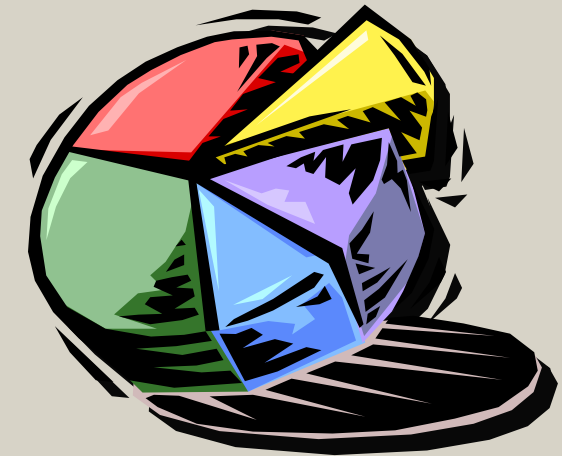
